

Title in BOLD CAPITALS, Centered, Font Times New Roman, 14 points, 18 point spacing after the title

First Author^{1*}, Second Author², ... (Font Times New Roman, 10 points, single line spacing)

¹Affiliation of the first author, * e-mail address of corresponding author (students are encouraged to use a g-mail address)

²Affiliation of the second author

³ Affiliation of the third author, etc. (leave a blank line between the last affiliation and the abstract)

Abstract: (not more than 200 words, Times New Roman, 11 points, 1.15 line spacing. All margins must be 25 mm, paragraphs are right justified). The abstract should state the objective of the paper, the techniques used, major results, and a conclusion. The use of full sentences is encouraged.

Keywords: 3 – 5 keywords

1. Introduction (bold, 12 points, 12 points line spacing after heading, and an 18 point line spacing before the heading)

Headings should be numbered sequentially, starting from the introduction as section 1. The last numbered heading is the Conclusion. Use a 9-point line spacing between paragraphs in a section. Use 11-point Times New Roman font for normal text. New paragraphs start flush to the left. The length of the paper should not exceed 8 pages.

The introduction should state the purpose of the work and explain its context in relation to the literature.

Equations should be numbered sequentially, with the equation number to the right of the equation. Use a cursive font for symbols/variables in the equations and in the text.

Tables should be numbered sequentially, with the table caption above the table. The table and caption should be centered.

Figures should be numbered sequentially, with the figure caption below the figure. Figures and their captions should be centered. Lettering should be larger than 2.5 mm after reduction.

A nomenclature declaring all the symbols and abbreviations used should be inserted between the conclusion and references. List the symbols alphabetically, starting with Roman, Greek, subscripts, superscripts, and abbreviations in separate groups.

Number references to the literature in the order that they first appear in the text. Put the numbers in square brackets. When listing references, use a 1 cm hanging indentation for the first line and a 0-point line spacing between references. When more than two authors are involved, list the first two, followed by et al.

The headings for the nomenclature and references are not numbered. An acknowledgment may be inserted before the list of references. The heading “Acknowledgment” is not numbered.
